

Why are we doing this?

We want to do better at keeping children safe and working well with fathers is part of that. We want to know what worked well for you and what didn't. Fathers whose children have been involved with the child welfare system have valuable insight about how these systems work and don't work. Based on what we hear from you, MCWAP will offer recommendations to the child welfare system about how to do a better job working with fathers.

What is MCWAP?

MCWAP is a multidisciplinary task force made up of private citizens and professionals that work with families impacted by child abuse and neglect. MCWAP's mission is to ensure the state system meets the safety, permanency, and well-being of children and families through assessment, research, case reviews, advocacy, and greater citizen involvement. The goal is to promote child safety and quality services for children, youth, and families.
